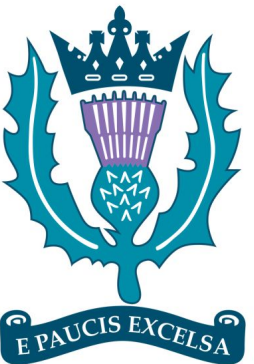


SPECIAL AWARDS
